

Current Recording Project Info **Updated: 9/24/09**

A few weeks ago we officially launched into a new recording project with Dave Beegle as producer. This project will include 5 of our songs that haven't been recorded yet and 4 of our songs from the For Your Glory CD that we helped to produce in 2004 for March for Jesus/YWAM. A few of the new songs will be recorded at the new Backbone Studios in Loveland with three of the best jazz/funk players around – Bijoux Barbosa (Bass), Eric Gunnison (Keys), and Christian Teele (Drums). This project will feature a wide variety of musical styles with blues, rock, celtic, funk, jazz and pop styles represented. For that reason we may call the CD, This and That - kind of a "tongue in cheek" comparison to our last CD, The Now And Then - not sure yet – we're open for suggestions! We're looking to have this CD out by February of 2010.

Something new that we are initiating with this project is an invitation to our friends to be a part of the production team through financial donations. The estimated production costs for this recording is \$10,000. Anyone interested in more details regarding this opportunity can visit the DONATION section of our website.

The New Songs are:

I've Been Washed – with a rowdy, funky vibe, this song speaks powerfully of the transforming power of redemption through the blood of Jesus - vocalist Charles Suggs will be featured on this track.

Wonderful – a rock based praise song that declares the goodness of God – the verse text is taken from Proverbs 30 - "has anyone one ever seen anyone ascended in the heavens..."

The Good News Blues – a fun blues song that encourages us to praise God in every situation.

And I Will Say – also has a funk groove and encourages believers to speak the truth about who God is in the midst of the storms of life.

Any Other Way – a "love song" I wrote for Susanne which will be recorded "old school jazz style" with acoustic piano and upright bass – we'll probably place this as the last song on the CD as a bonus track.

The previously recorded songs from the For Your Glory CD are:

We've Come Together – a call to worship with an emphases on lifting up God's name as a unified body - one Body, one Spirit, one Faith.

Praise The Lord With Everything – a fun, up-tempo Latin feel with much of the text taken from Psalm 150.

Holy Is The Lord – a deep worship song, with a celtic flavor that has become a regular worship song in many churches.

For Your Glory – this song, of surrender to the purposes of God, was the title cut from the For Your Glory/March For Jesus recording.
